SAFETY COURSE



Safety Course Information:

Wisconsin has mandatory safety education for anyone riding a public trail. The requirement for this certification is:

Anyone who is at least 12 years old and anyone born on or after January 1, 1988. These ATV operators must carry their safety certification card and they must display it to law enforcement officers when requested.

<u>Exception</u>: In 2013, the Wisconsin ATV Association helped pass legislation to exempt the mandatory safety education rule during an organized demonstration ride. The VIP falls under this type of event so participants <u>do not need</u> to have any ATV safety certificate.

A brief introductory safety course will be conducted on site for those that do not know how to ride. This is not the same DNR safety course mentioned above.



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

What To Bring:

Our VIP ride is held rain or shine, and in the past we've had our share of rain! We suggest bringing a change of clothes in case you encounter some mud on the trails. If you have your own helmet, please feel free to bring that along with any other gear of your choosing. If you don't have any safety gear don't worry, we have a large selection of helmets, goggles and gloves for everyone.



TRAIL AMBASSADOR INFORMATION

The Trail Ambassadors are a visible presence on the trail systems. This presence sends a powerful message to all of the users, as well as the land managers and local citizens that are connected to the trail system.

The trail ambassadors focuses on the following items:

- Assistance to stranded or lost riders
- Law and ordinance compliance
- Safety concerns regarding trail conditions
- Trail sign issues
- GPS mapping services
- A presence of volunteers that are dedicated to a positive image of their sport

Our trail ambassadors are trained to not only be a watchful eye for the items listed above, but to be an ambassador of the sport. We pride our trail patrol services on lending a helpful hand to anyone that needs assistance.

During the VIP Ride, groups going out on the trail must have a team of trail ambassadors with them. This is for everyone's safety.
